Labyrinth Walk – We are all on a journey, a path. The labyrinth is a model of that path. A labyrinth is an ancient symbol that relates to wholeness. It combines the imagery of the circle and the spiral into a meandering but purposeful path. The Labyrinth represents a journey to our own center and back again out into the world. Labyrinths have long been used as meditation and prayer tools. During Holy Week, the labyrinth can represent our journey to the cross and resurrection in the footsteps of Jesus. A Labyrinth will be available from Wednesday during Holy Week through Holy Saturday in the Ballroom. Handouts will offer you various ways in which to meditate by walking the labyrinth. Any time the building is open, you are welcome to come. A guided walk will be offered on Wednesday of Holy Week at 7pm.

Friday, April 22 - Good Friday

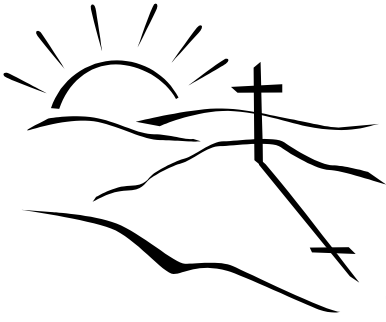
12:00 Noon Good Friday Liturgy with Communion from the Reserved Sacrament in the church (English)
